## ARTHUR | YOUNG ADULT

Kannon is neutered, vaccinated and heartworm negative... aka ready to go! He has a really nice demeanor, albeit a bit timid coming out of the shelter. We'll give him some time to decompress and show his true colors while we get to know him.



# SIMON | SENIOR HW Positive\*

---

Adorable senior bullie Mr Simon is ready for his foster to adopt home!

We have learned Simon loves to go for car rides and long walks. He enjoys all types of snacks (except carrots) and enjoys hanging out with his people in the evening on a comfy bed. He would prefer to be the only bullie in the house and no cats, either! We are treating Simon's heartworms at no cost to adopter – **Simon has no adoption fee to an approved home.**

A testament to what a little bit of TLC and vet care can do! We've included Simon's shelter photo... he was surrendered to the shelter to be euthanized because - after 11 years of living in the back yard - their "pet" had skin issues, eye issues and is heartworm positive.

## ZEUS | ADULT

Zeus is around two - three years old and super friendly, great on leash, good with other dogs and very sweet. Quite the perfect bull terrier!

Arlo is a smaller lad at about 32lbs – he is good with other dogs, but no cats or small furies! He loves to sleep in his crate, is a very easy foster – low key, relaxed and has nice manners. Arlo has begun heartworm treatment.





## BLANCO | ADULT

Blanco came to us after being abandoned by his owner after they moved. He had been tied to tree for 5 years. Blanco is well behaved and good on leash.

He is heartworm negative and ready for a new active family.

Trevor is about 3 years old and has begun heartworm treatment. This boy is good on a leash, a little rambunctious but settles quickly. He has been good with other dogs and kids aged 5+.



# TYRION | ADULT

Tyrion ("Ty") is an older guy (6-7 years old), but he's got the energy of a young pup. He loves to go on long walks in the park, play fetch, and hucklebutt. He gets along well with other dogs; his foster home has another bully who he loves to play with, and he is great about leaving their older dog (who doesn't like to play) alone.

Physically, you can tell he has been through a lot in life. His hip was broken, and he has some scarring on his elbows (maybe from crawling with a broken hip). His coat has gotten much better, and he's come a long way from his condition two months ago, when he was brought into a local Houston shelter to be euthanized.

Ty has lots of love and energy, is responsive and eager to learn, and is growing more beautiful every day. Despite his age, he would be a great fit for an active person, even one who is at work for long hours but wants to come home and play around with their best friend. He is still learning his manners with taking treats gently, and has torn up a dog bed. He needs a little time to simmer down and relax for "let's just hang out and watch TV" time.

Ty has been living comfortably with a foster family since July and now he is ready to find his forever home! Tyrion has begun heartworm treatment and is ready for a foster-to-adopt home.





# PHOEBE | ADULT

HW Positive\*

This sweet mama came to us with her two adolescent daughters; rescued from a life of breeding, spent outdoors on a chain. When we saw her daughter, Rachel, being sold on Facebook for \$75 we jumped into action with the assistance of a local advocate. Their advocate did not leave until she had secured all 3 dogs surrender. Unfortunately, all 3 are heartworm positive.

Phoebe is about 4 years old, sweet and petite. Her personality is starting to shine in foster care and she is showing off her silly bullie side.

Phoebe has begun heartworm treatment and is ready to move to a foster-to-adopt home.
